TO: **Parties affected by Sewer Repairs to be done in the Harbor Lights Area**

FROM: **Lyndon Sanitary District # 1 Commissioners**

RE: **Wisconsin DNR Permit Notice and Project Schedule For Sewer Repairs**

This memorandum addresses 1) a public notice required by the Wisconsin DNR Permit process and 2) anticipated project schedule for the repair of sewer lines in the Harbor Lights area.

1. **Background.** The existing sanitary sewers along Harbor Lights Court and Harbor Lights Road (at creek crossing) have “sunk”. The lines are sufficiently sunken whereby they no longer provide gravity flow and more significantly are in danger of breaking. As a result, the sunken sections must be replaced. You may have noticed the color paint marks on the pavement at these sites as part of the preparations and planning for the repairs.
2. **Permits.** The projects require permits from the Wisconsin DNR, Army Corps of Engineers and Sheboygan County Planning and Zoning.
 - a. The attached Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources public notice is for your reference. The Wisconsin DNR requires that the Sanitary District provide a copy of this notice to parties in proximity to the projects.
3. **Anticipated Project Schedule**
 - a. The District’s Contract schedules specifies that the work is to be started after Labor Day to help limit disruption to residents and the Resort.
 - b. **Harbor Lights Court (manholes 6 - 6A).** The District’s Contractor will start the project after Labor Day upon receiving the Wisconsin DNR permits. The work should take approximately 4 weeks (start to finish). We anticipate completing this project first.
 - c. **Harbor Lights Road (manholes 4 - 5).** The District’s Contractor will start the project after Labor Day upon receiving the Wisconsin DNR permits. The work should take approximately 4 weeks (start to finish) by Contract. We anticipate completing this project second; i.e., after completion of the Harbor Lights Court project.
4. **Access to the Harbor Lights Area**
 - a. Access to the area will maintained throughout the construction. There may be temporary inconveniences at some points during the course of carrying out the projects.
 - b. A short temporary gravel road along the shoulder of Harbor Lights Road will provide access when the Harbor Lights Road project is underway.

We are looking forward to eliminating this sewer problem and its high potential risk of service failure by carrying out the planned repairs. We also appreciate your patience for any inconvenience you may encounter during the construction.
